

Virginia Cider Week: Corcoran Vineyards & Cider

Cider Maker:

Lori Corcoran has always enjoyed farming and getting her hands dirty. Shortly after starting their vineyard back in 2001, Lori and her family decided they would keep their grapes and begin making wine. Lori studied hands-on at first, and later went to Virginia Tech where she learned the chemistry side of winemaking. In 2013, the Corcorans decided to add hard cider to their lineup. With a blend of seven different locally grown apples, Lori started fermenting and making cider.

Cidery:

Corcoran Vineyards & Cider is a small, family-owned winery situated on the Corcoran family farm in Loudoun County. Their production started at 550 cases in 2002, and they are currently producing about 5,000 cases of wine and cider.

Corcoran Vineyards & Cider currently offers one dry, crisp cider and will be sharing four new ciders come the end of fall and winter.
